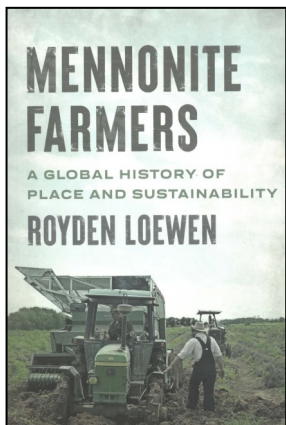


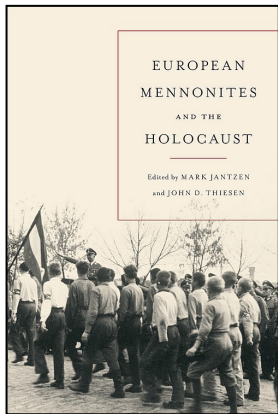

Royden Loewen. *Mennonite Farmers: A Global History of Place and Sustainability* (2021) ~~\$31.95~~ \$28.75

Mennonite farmers can be found in dozens of countries spanning five continents. In this comparative, world-scale environmental history, Royden Loewen draws on a multi-year study of seven Anabaptist communities around the world, focusing on Mennonite farmers in Bolivia, Canada, Indonesia, the Netherlands, Russia, the United States, and Zimbabwe. These farmers, among the Amish, Brethren in Christ, and Siberian Baptists, till the land in starkly different climates. Loewen gives voice to their distinct perceptions and experiences, each reflecting particular faith outlooks, historical memories, and natural environments.

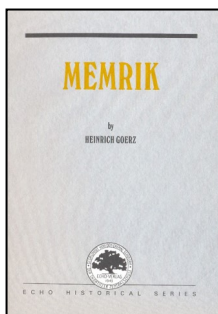

During the Second World War, Mennonites in the Netherlands, Germany, occupied Poland, and Ukraine lived in communities with Jews and close to various Nazi camps and killing sites. As a result of this proximity, Mennonites were neighbours to and witnessed the destruction of European Jews. In some cases they were beneficiaries or even enablers of the Holocaust. Much of

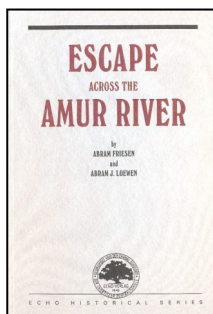
this history was forgotten after the war, as Mennonites sought to rebuild or find new homes as refugees. The result was a myth of Mennonite innocence and ignorance that connected their own suffering during the 1930s and 1940s with earlier centuries of persecution and marginalization. **Book Review in *Mennonite Historian* Vol. 47 No. 4 December 2021, p. 11.**

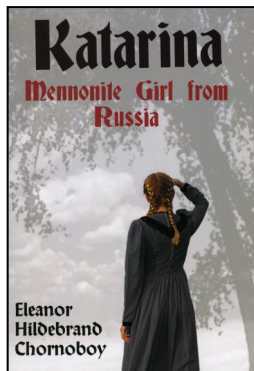

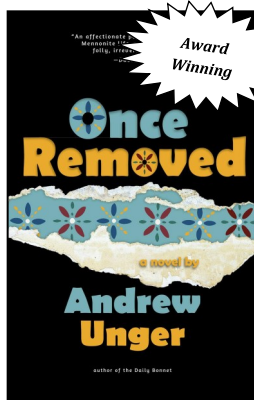

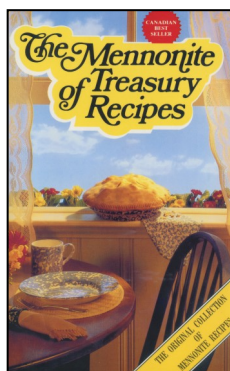


Andrew Unger. *Once Removed* (2020) \$19.95

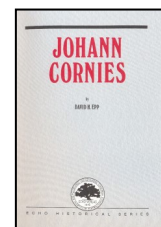
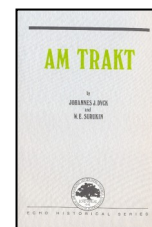
and a good deal of fried bologna, Timothy must find his own voice to tell the one story that could make--or break--him.
