To the honourable Expedition of the Empire's Economy!

The undersigned appointed Mennonites of Chortitza find it necessary to humbly present to you, since we received this request from our brethren, to tell you of the sad circumstances they are in at present. Honourable Collegio under August 20, 1798 and October 22, 1799, asked repeatedly that their state could be softened through the grace of Your Majesty, the Empress.

So the appointed see it as their duty to address the honourable Expedition of the Empire's Economy that they would use their influence and address the goodwill of Your Majesty, that a letter would be sent with a copy to us that would lessen the miserable circumstances that the Mennonites find themselves in. We humbly ask for this.
